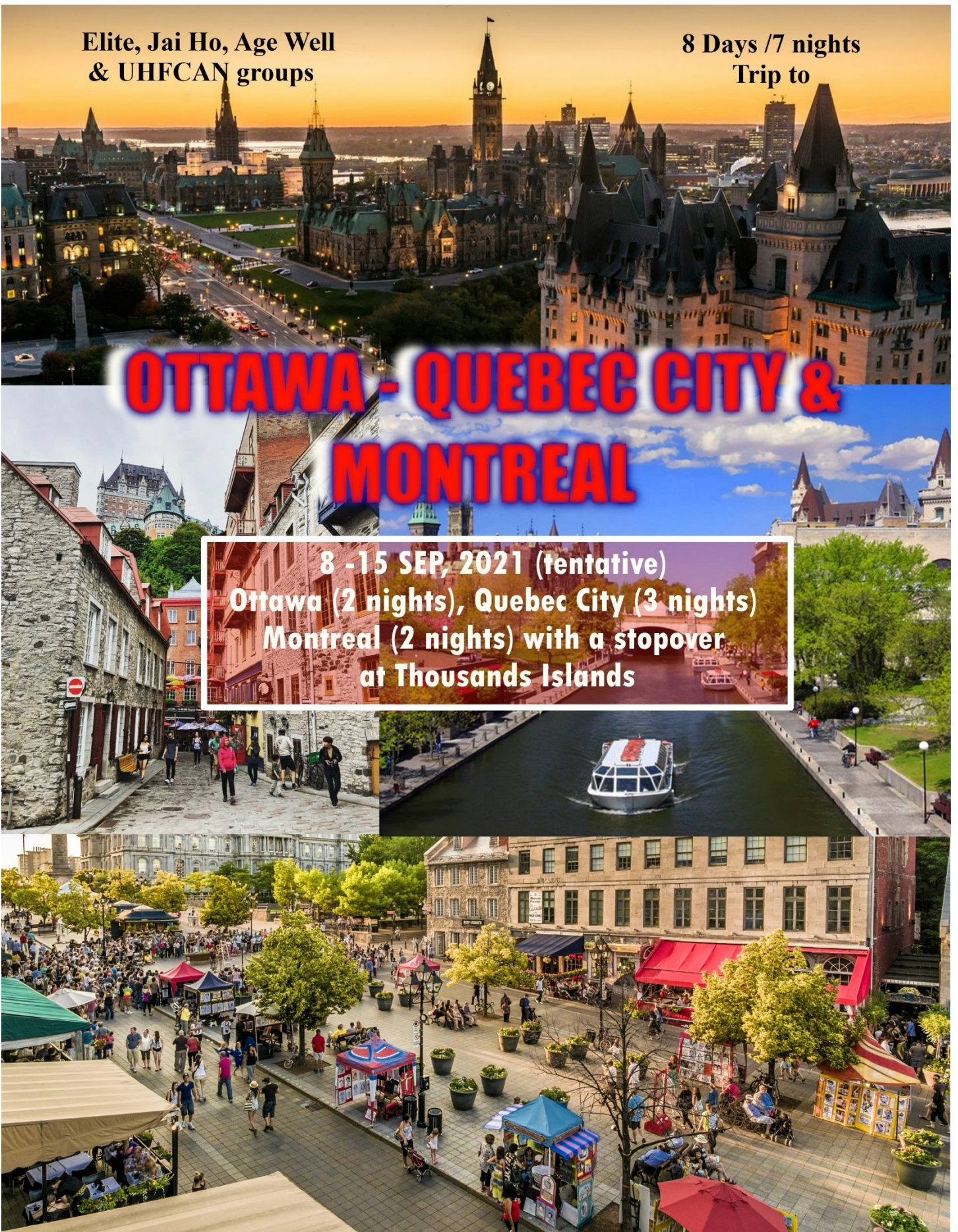

Ontario & Québec Discovery September 2021 (8 Days /7 Nights)

This is the estimate at this stage as no accommodations or transport or pertaining to our group have been booked. (**LAST DATE TO BOOK: Sat July 24, 2021 to fix the cost. A \$200 deposit per person is required – First 34 people will be accepted**)

IMPORTANT CONDITION: All the members coming on this tour must be double vaccinated for Covid 19 and will be required to sign the undertaking to that regard. It is possible that at Ontario/Quebec order, they might ask for vaccination certificate to prove that you have taken both doses of COVID 19 vaccine. So keep the certificate handy along with your passports.

Day 1 - Wednesday, September 8, 2021 Drive **Toronto – Ottawa**



Today we get together at the parking lot of Denison Center (Dennison & Kennedy) in Markham at 9:00 am (tentative) and leave at 9:30 am sharp to Ottawa by our own private luxury, air-conditioned big bus (seats 50) with onboard wifi and washroom for an approximately 4.5-hour journey to Ottawa, Canada's Capital City. After arriving in Ottawa, we check in. The remainder of the day is at your leisure to experience the exciting streets of such a cultural and walkable city. I suggest a visit to the Parliament Hill Visitor Centre, or the Byward market and then have a seat at one of the beautiful natural parks that Ottawa has to offer.

Accommodation: Ottawa - Hilton Garden Inn Ottawa Downtown 361 Queen St West (downtown)



The Hilton Garden Inn Ottawa Downtown hotel, conveniently situated in downtown Ottawa, is steps from Parliament Hill with subway transportation at the hotel's front door for easy access to many points of interest. Each guest room features a desk, 50-inch HDTV with premium channels, and oversized windows that flood the room with sunlight. WiFi is free, and there is a mini-refrigerator, microwave, and coffeemaker for your convenience.

Day 2 - Thursday, September 9, 2021 **Ottawa**



Today we explore Ottawa aboard our bus. Visit may include popular sites such as Parliament Hill, embassies, parks, museums, the Byward Market and the Rideau Canal. Admission is not included to any museum or monuments. After our coach tour we may explore by water on a scenic cruise (extra) of the wonderful Rideau Canal. Be surprised by the richness and historical landmarks that we will discover on this afternoon cruise!

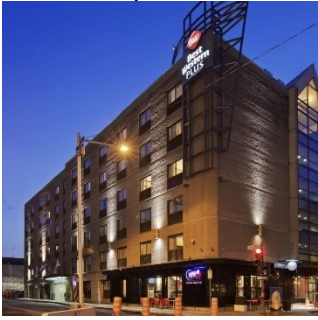
Day 3 - Friday, September 10, 2021 **Ottawa – Québec City by our private bus**



Today we checkout and leave Ottawa after breakfast (extra) on a 4.5 hours journey by our private bus to Québec City, a UNESCO World Heritage treasure. The city lies on the St. Lawrence River and is the oldest European settlement in Canada. The old quarter is the only walled city in North America. A coach transfer is provided to our hotel upon arrival. Take some time to explore Québec City's charms on your own this evening.

Accommodation: Québec City – Best Western Plus Hotel - 330 Rue De La Couronne, Quebec (CITY CENTRE downtown)



This hotel is 15 minutes' walk from **Old Quebec City** and the Quebec Convention Centre. It features an **indoor pool** and spacious rooms with free WiFi.

A high-definition TV and coffee maker are standard in every room at Best Western Plus Centre-ville/City Centre. All rooms include a work desk and a large private bathroom with marble counter tops.

The on-site restaurant, Bistro Le 330, and on-site coffee shop, Café In, serve breakfast every morning for a surcharge. Please note that breakfast is not included in the room rate. Best Western Plus Centre-ville/City Centre Québec is 10 minutes' drive from the Battlefields Park and Quebec National Museum of Fine Arts. Laurier Quebec Mall and the Quebec City Aquarium are both within 12 km. This is our guests' favourite part of Quebec City, according to independent reviews..

Day 4 - Saturday, September 11, 2021 Québec City



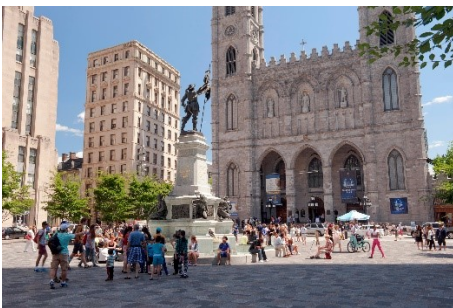
On today's City tour, we will explore much of what the area has to offer. We may Experience the European charm of the first French settlement in North America. This is your chance to visit history first hand. The Latin Quarter, Plains of Abraham, Ramparts, world-famous Château Frontenac, National Assembly, Basilica, City Hall, Place-Royale, and a glimpse of modern Québec City are the perfect introduction to the city.

Next, we travel back in time to rural Québec and enjoy the view! As we ride along the Chemin du Roy to Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré, we will pass through the many traditional villages of rural Québec. In Sainte-Anne de Beaupré, we will be given time to visit the world-famous Shrine. We will also stop at the Montmorency Falls

(1 1/2 times higher than Niagara Falls). Just as you think our day is over, we could choose to go far a short visit on the Island of Orléans, discovered by Jacques Cartier in 1535, where the picturesque village of Sainte-Pétronille, with its 19th century rural atmosphere, waits to be rediscovered again.

Day 5 - Sunday, September 12, 2021 Québec City



Today we take a private walking tour. Our bus will drop us at the old Quebec location. This tour will lead us on a leisurely descending path through all the important sites of Old Québec. We will see the architecture, the marking events and the Québec people's history. We meander next to Québec historical sites such as Chateau Frontenac, Québec fortifications, Place Royale and uncover many hidden Québec sites! We will stop at La Citadels de Québec/Musée Royal 22^e Régiment to explore this fortress—an active garrison of the Royal 22^e Régiment—and delve deeply into this National Historic Site with its impressive architecture and spectacular views of the city and St. Lawrence River. At Musée de la civilisation (admission price not included) we will discover magnificent

exhibits of international calibre about Québec culture and history.

Day 6 - Monday, September 13, 2021 Quebec City – Montréal by our private bus



Today we checkout of the hotel and board the bus for a 3-hour journey to Montreal. Upon arrival, we check in at the designated hotel, then the afternoon is free to explore this stylish and elegant city with a distinctly European flair offering a vibrant mix of the old and new. Here you can immerse yourself in the French heritage of North America. Stroll through narrow cobbled lanes with 17th century buildings, quaint shops, galleries and sidewalk cafés. Montréal is a city with a thousand different flavours, from award-winning restaurants to ethnic food stalls and locally grown products.
